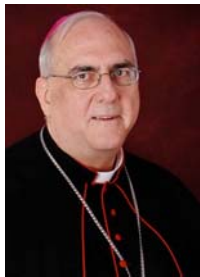


About our keynote speakers:



Most Reverend Joseph F. Naumann was born and raised in St. Louis, and was ordained a priest of that Archdiocese on May 24th, 1975. After serving as a parish priest for 10 years, the Archbishop was named Coordinator of the Archdiocesan Pro Life Committee and served in that capacity for 11 years. From 1994 to 2003, Archbishop Naumann served as the Vicar General for the Archdiocese and was named an Auxiliary Bishop of St. Louis in 1997. On January 7, 2004, he was named Coadjutor Archbishop of Kansas City, KS and assumed responsibilities as the Archbishop on January 15, 2005.

Archbishop Naumann currently serves on a number of boards and committees, most notably the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' Committee on Pro Life Activities. And he has a direct link to the Bishops' Pro Life Office in Nebraska. In 1992, then Fr. Naumann came to Nebraska to help establish the post-abortion outreach of Project Rachel in all three of our dioceses. Archbishop Naumann has also gained national attention with his firm but pastoral public admonishment of former Kansas Governor Kathleen Sebelius, a Catholic, for her actions and views in support of abortion.

Lila Rose is a pro-life student activist at UCLA who has dedicated her life to ending abortion. At fifteen years old, Lila founded Live Action, which is now a growing nonprofit with several chapters in California.

Live Action uses "new media" at both the community and national level to educate and mobilize youth, and to spread a pro-life message to the next generation. Live Action (www.liveaction.org) also conducts student-led investigations. Most notably, Lila has led several successful undercover investigations exposing racism and sexual abuse cover-ups by Planned Parenthood. Her brave work has revealed new evidence to build a strong case against the abortion industry and lobby.

Lila is a frequent guest on radio and television programs, including The O'Reilly Factor, Hannity's America, and The Laura Ingraham show. Numerous newspapers and blogs have also printed articles about her investigations, including the Wall Street Journal, Salon Magazine Online, The Washington Times and National Review.
